Justine Simpson Foundation Provides Health Care Services to Over 200 Residents

Camperdown, St. Ann

Over 200 residents from Clover Hill, Camperdown, Jeferyville and Tydixon benefitted from a health fair hosted by the Justine Simpson Foundation at the Camperdown All Age School in St. Ann today. The initiative was supported by over forty medical staff and volunteers from Georgia, North East Regional Health Authority (NERHA), friends of the Simpsons and community members. Patrons accessed screenings for Diabetes, Hypertension, HIV and many other services.

Mr. Wayne Simpson, President of the Justine Simpson Foundation based in Kennesaw, Georgia said he “plans to make this health outreach an annual one, and will be targeting other underserved areas”. The Foundation, inspired out of the passing of baby Justine Victoria Simpson over a year ago, is currently in the process of procuring US\$1-2 million dollars worth of medical equipment for the St. Ann’s Bay Regional Hospital.

Mr. Wesley Davis, Board Chairman of NERHA, Dr. Nicole Dawkins, Senior Medical Officer and Mr. Keith Richards, Chief Executive Officer of the St. Ann’s Bay Hospital endorsed the initiative and thanked the Foundation for the health services rendered to the citizens, and all efforts made by the foundation in honour of baby Justine.
